







## Noise complaints and queries that Shared Regulatory Services is unable to assist with

We are generally unable to assist with noise complaints where the source is:

**Children playing** - e.g. in a garden, public space or parkspeech (talking and shouting)

**Domestic noise** - unless unreasonably loud or at unreasonable times day-to-day (lawn mowing, hedge trimming, washing machines, vacuuming)

**Everyday living** - (footsteps, light switches being turned on / off, general talking, doors closing/banging, pressing door buzzes, toilet flushing, babies crying, moving furniture, rowdy behaviour in stairwells/communal areas). Contact your tenancy officer or landlord regarding these matters

Rowdy behaviour outside in the street (public order offences) - this is a police matter. Ring 101. Please look at the South Wales Police website <a href="mailto:south-wales.police.uk">south-wales.police.uk</a> and If you feel threatened ring 999.
